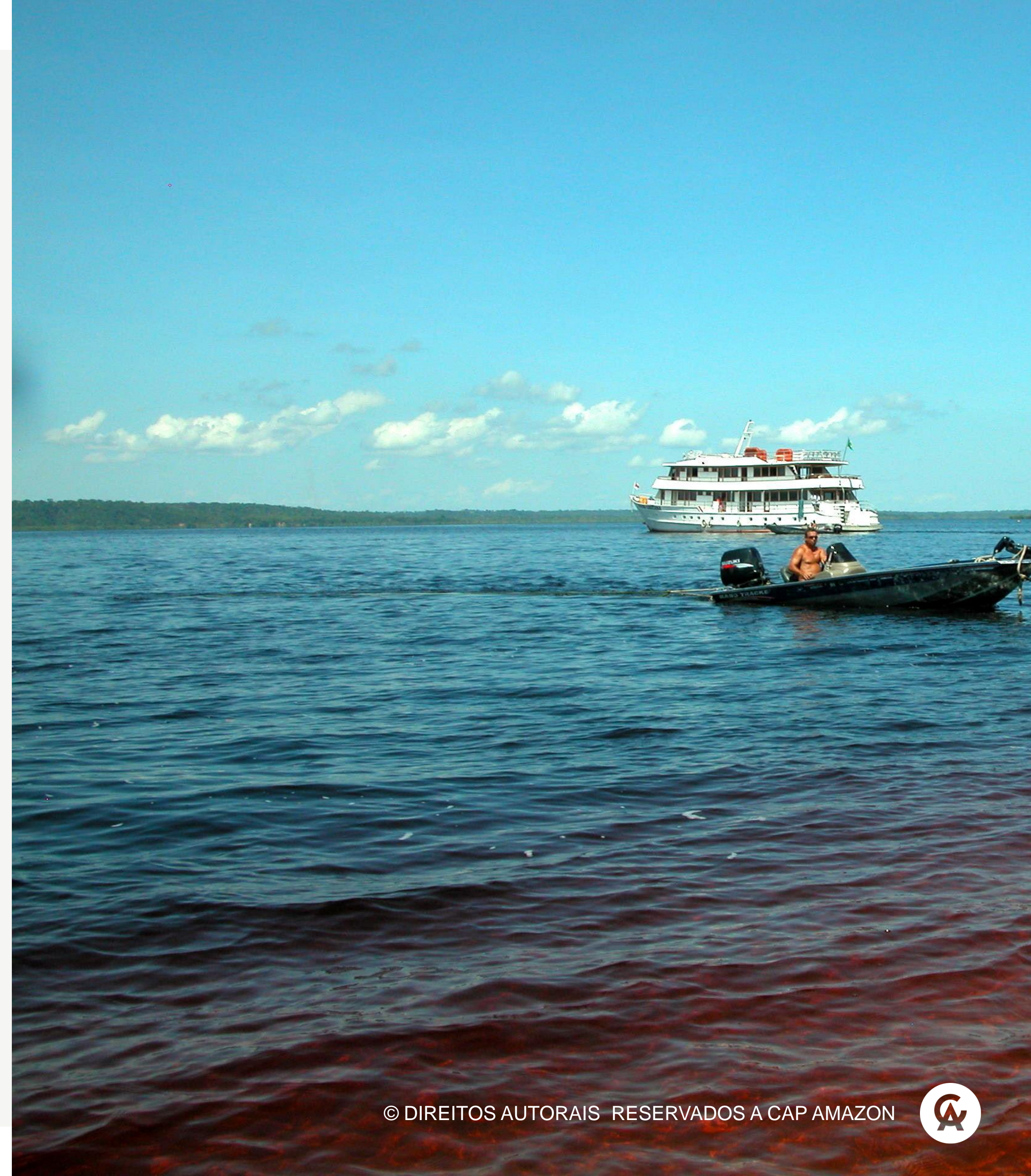

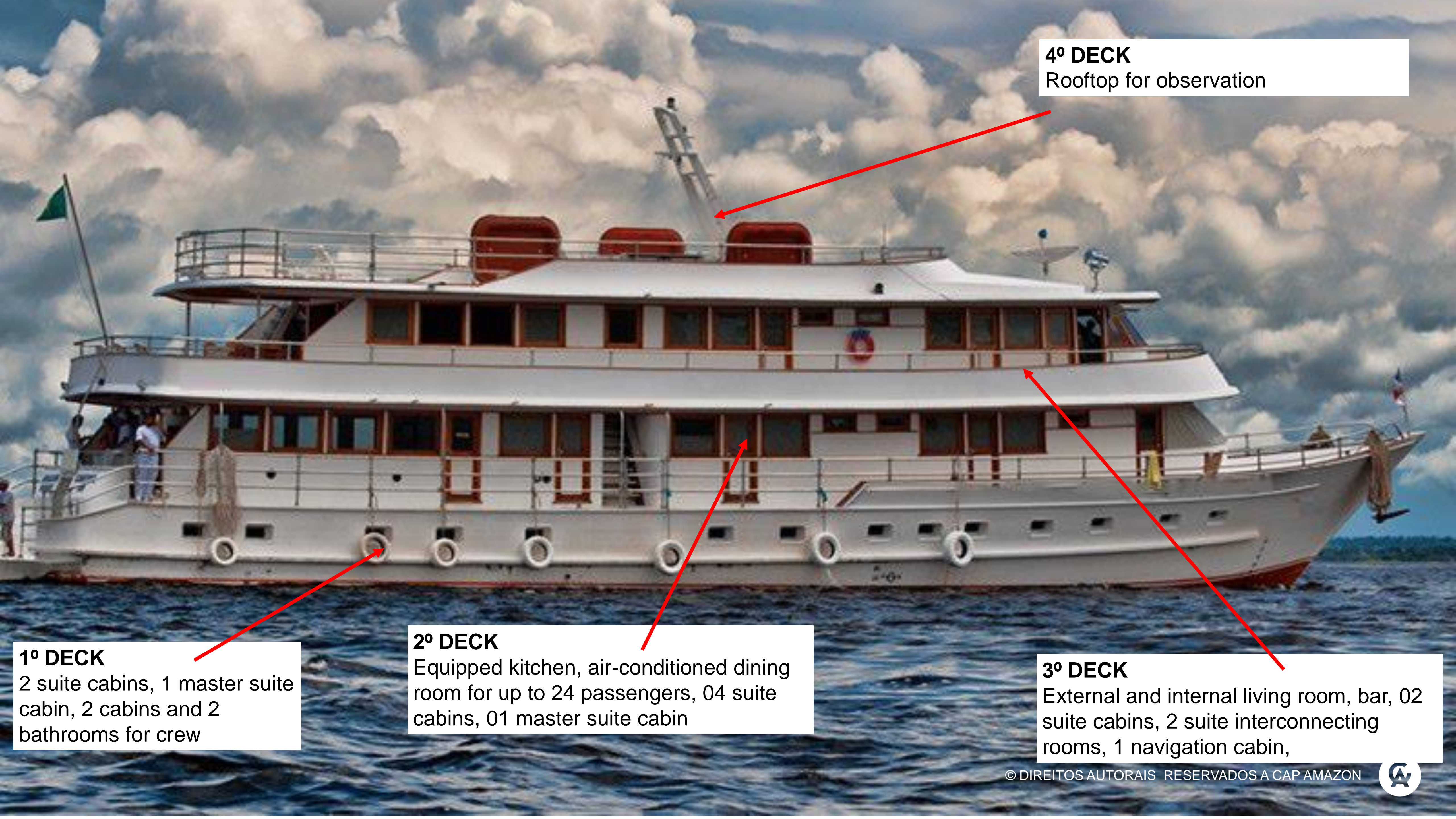

We have a selection of national drinks included: mineral water, natural juices, soft drinks, national beer, caipirinhas ...

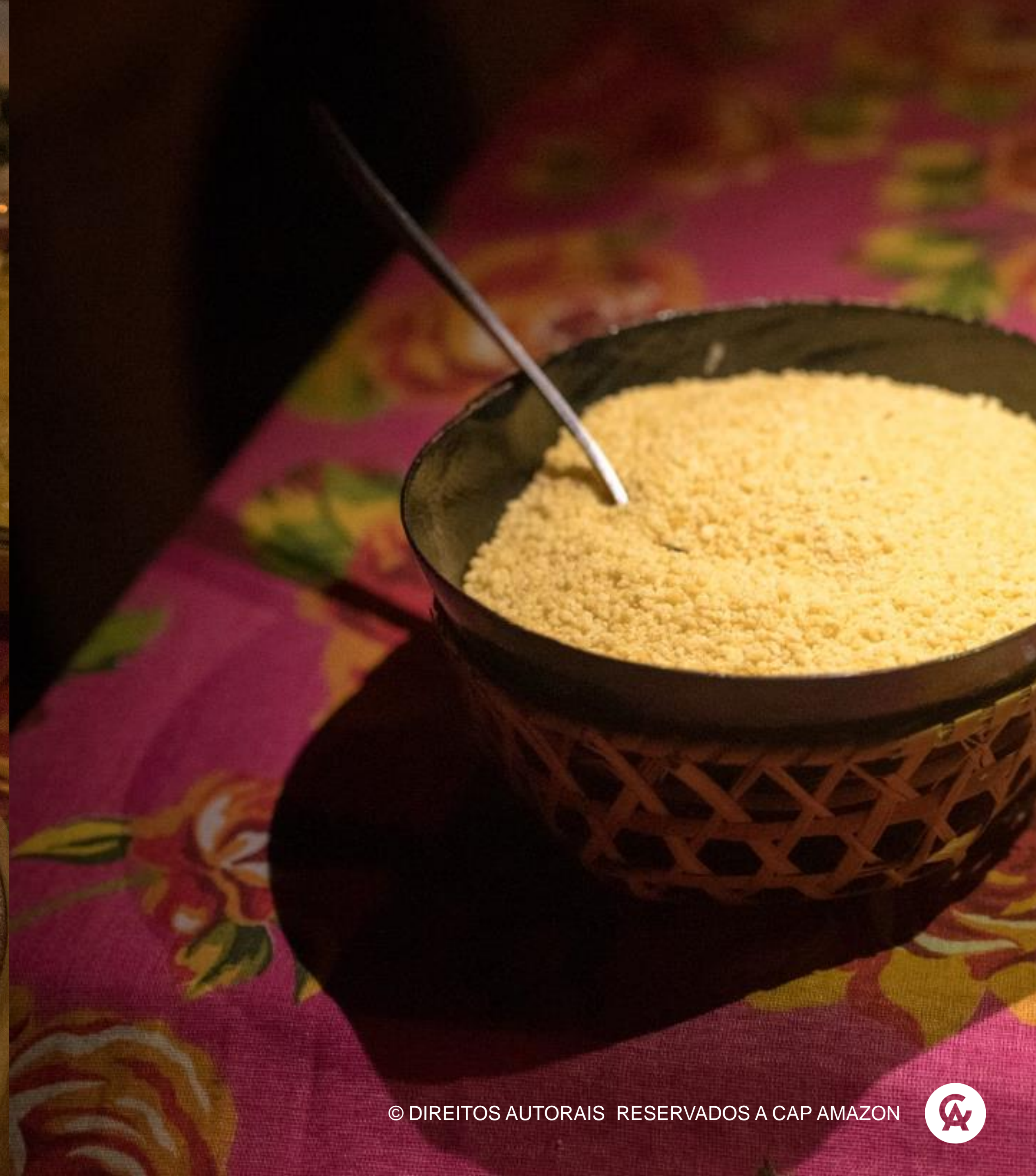
Imported drinks can be ordered in advance and will be charged separately.

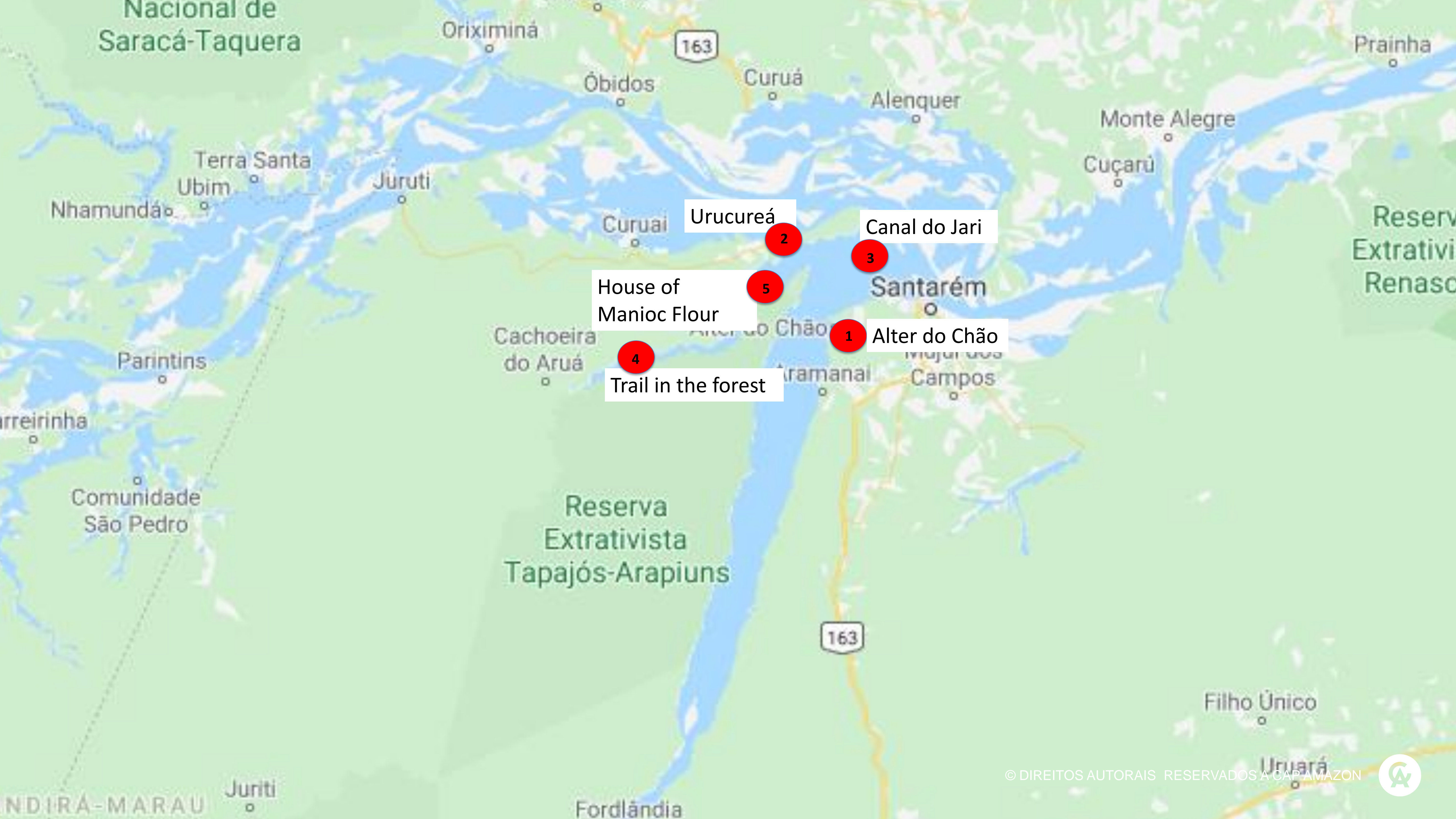

REGULAR DEPARTURES ON THE TAPAJÓS RIVER

Day 1:

Boarding at Alter do Chão and experience with Urucureá Community

Visit to a riverside community in the region, where we will learn about the ancient tradition of making handicrafts with tucumã straw, a typical fruit of the region.

Workshop with the artisans, dyeing processes and characteristics of traditional braiding.

Before lunch, stop for a swim and arrival at Canal do Jari, a narrow arm of the Amazon River.

Overnight and dinner on board.

REGULAR DEPARTURES ON THE TAPAJÓS RIVER

Day 2 :

Trail in the forest

Wake up at the Arapiuns River.

Trail through the native forest, accompanied by a local guide who will introduce us to some of the rich Amazonian flora.

At the end, a bath in the stream of crystalline water.

In the afternoon, after lunch we will continue sailing towards a new beach.

Overnight and dinner on board.

Visit the typical flour house to see the production process of food derived from manioc.

Our last afternoon will be at another beautiful beach on the edge of Arapiuns.

At night, we will make a traditional “piracaia”: grilled fish on the beach in a very special setting!
